<u>'Gainful Use of TSA 2022 Materials' STAR Online Mode</u> User Guide – Trial Assessment Materials

STAR is an online assessment item bank with more than 59,000 assessment items covering the subjects of Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 3. With a view to persistently enhancing learning and teaching effectiveness, catering for students' learning diversity as well as strengthening Assessment for Learning and assessment literacy, the platform has been upgraded since October 2020, extending the coverage progressively from Basic Competencies to Full Curriculum of Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics. Apart from the relatively vast amount of reading assessment tasks for language subjects currently offered, STAR 2.0 encompasses more listening, speaking and writing assessment tasks. The assessment items of Mathematics in parallel covers the learning objectives of the Non-foundation Topics (applicable to Key Stage 3) by phases.

To further enhance user experience on the platform, new and enhanced features on STAR were rolled out by batches in October 2020 and April 2021 for schools to incorporate STAR into their routine learning / teaching and school-based assessments as a regular and frequently-used assessment tool. 

Select the subject.




On the 'Preset papers' tab, select trial assessment materials, then click to view the paper details.




Click 'Save as new paper'.



On the 'My papers' tab, view the saved preset papers and click / to edit the paper title and status.




On the 'Add task(s) to paper' tab, edit the 'Paper title' and 'Description' of the paper.




On the 'Publish paper' tab, select the target student / group, available time and answer settings for students.
